However, the input from comments, along with other forms of information, will be considered as the team undertakes its work and develops recommendations to the institution. Institutional reports, on-campus interviews, and email comments become part of the information collected and reviewed by the team.</p> <p>The email account is created for this visit only and will be closed once the WSCUC team leaves the campus.
